INSTRUCTIONS

Re: Attendance at Billings Central Catholic High School

Deadline: April 6, 2018

ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicant must be a young woman and a registered member of St. Bernard's Parish.
2. She must be entering grade 9-12 at Billings Central in the fall of 2018.
3. She must carry a minimum C+ or 2.5 G.P.A.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicant must:

1. Complete attached Application form, and enclose:
 - a) Transcript of school records for the last two years;
 - b) Statement of not more than 100 words, in her own handwriting, giving her views on the importance and benefits of Catholic education. She should include information about her family and her financial benefit from receiving this scholarship.
2. Submit a letter of recommendation from her principal, guidance counselor, teacher, or coach. The following points may be used as a guide for such letter:
 - a) What are applicant's personal traits, leadership qualities, special talents, and participation in school and extra-curricular activities?
 - b) Are there additional children in the family attending St. Francis Elementary/Middle/Upper, Billings Central Catholic High School, or a Catholic college?
