- Compass - with screw adjustment and dedicated lead (not the ones you put a pencil into); good quality (\$10-\$15)
- Protractor, bendable (these break easily if made of stiff plastic)
- Ruler with both inches and centimeters (often protractors have these on the bottom edge, no need for a separate ruler)
- Calculator - Scientific with Trig functions (sin cos tan) suffices, but TI-84 Plus graphing is recommended. Ipad calculator is not sufficient.
- Colored pencils; basic color set
- 3-ring (1.5 inch) binder; 14 tabbed dividers; notebook – college ruled (70 pages is enough)

Algebra 1, Alg 2/Trig:

- 3-ring binder
- Loose leaf paper
- Graph paper
- pencils
- TI-84 calculator

- TI-84 calculator
