



BCCHS and SFC 2020 Spectator Plan

- **ATTENDANCE:**
 - Outdoor Events -
 - 4 guests per team roster participant for BCS families
 - 2 guests per team roster participant for visiting families
 - 2 administrative passes per school
 - 2 guests per coach
 - Indoor Events -
 - 2 guests per team roster participant for BCS families
 - 2 guests per team roster participant for visiting families
 - 2 administrative passes per school
 - 2 guests per coach
- **CHEERLEADERS:**
 - Cheerleaders will participate at indoor and outdoor events
 - 2 guests per cheer roster participant for BCS families
- **PEP BAND:**
 - Pep Band will participate outdoors at football
 - 2 guests per band roster participant for BCS families
- **ADMITTANCE PROCEDURE:** BCCHS participants and visitor participants will each receive the allotted number of tickets to distribute to family members of their choice. Tickets and admission fees must be presented to the ticket taker before spectators will be allowed to enter. No additional tickets will be given for any extenuating circumstances. To ensure consistency and safety, no exceptions will be made.
 - Price of Admission:
 - BCCHS - Adults \$6, School Age Children \$4, Seniors, 55 and older, \$2
 - SFC- Adults \$3, School Age Children \$2, Seniors, 55 and older, \$2
 - No Ticket - No Entry - No exceptions
- **FACE COVERINGS REQUIRED:** Face coverings will be required throughout for both indoor and outdoor events, beginning when a spectator enters the venue and continuing until the spectator leaves the venue. Noncompliance on the part of spectators will result in a suspension of play.
- **PHYSICAL DISTANCING REQUIRED:** Household members may sit or stand together with a minimum of six feet in all directions of other fans. It is recommended that when people yell or cheer, they maintain a distance greater than six feet, as respiratory droplets travel a greater distance with more volume.
- **ALTERNATE, SUB-VARSITY and MIDDLE SCHOOL VENUES:**
 - SFC Football Fields – Fans are required to stay behind the track at all times. Fans will not be allowed to stand on the field or track.
 - For non-seated venues such as cross-country, fans will be asked to stand back a minimum of 10 feet from the main field or course and must stay outside of all flagged areas.

- **POST-GAME:** Family members and spectators in attendance must leave the venue immediately following the event. Postgame gatherings on or off the field or court are not permitted. In multi-level sports, such as volleyball, fans may watch their own student's level only. Staying to watch the next level is not permitted unless the student or their sibling is also playing at the next level.
- **FACILITIES:** Where appropriate, additional porta-potties will be provided for outdoor events and cleaned and sanitized on a regular basis. All bathrooms and other facilities will also be cleaned and sanitized on a regular basis throughout all events.
- **FIELD PASS PROCEDURES for MEDIA, GAME WORKERS AND VOLUNTEERS:** Each school will follow the procedures they have followed in past years for chain crews, photographers, and videographers. Only one photographer and videographer per school will be allowed. All media, game workers and volunteers must have a pass and must follow all physical distancing and face masking procedures.
- **NON-COMPLIANCE:**
 - Failure to comply with spectator guidelines will result in suspension of play and potentially the spectator's loss of privilege to attend events
- **ATTENDANCE BY COLLEGE RECRUITERS:**
 - The coach/recruiter is required to get permission to attend each individual event by contacting the principal or activity director of the school where student athlete is enrolled
 - The coach/recruiter will be required to follow all guidelines set forth by the BCCHS and SFC Spectator Plan
 - The coach/recruiter will be asked to leave the event venue immediately following the end of the game; if the coach/recruiter wants to meet with the student athlete, they can make arrangements with the student athlete and their family to meet at a later time
 - No more than two coaches/recruiters from any one institution will be allowed to attend any given event
 - Failure of the coach/recruiter to comply with the guidelines of the BCCHS and SFC Spectator Plan will result in suspension of the privilege to attend BCCHS events
- **CONCESSIONS:** Concessions will not be available at any events during the fall season. Availability of concessions will be re-evaluated based on changes to the spectator plan throughout the 2020-21 school year
- **AT RISK INDIVIDUALS:** BCCHS and SFC strongly recommend that family members who are at risk or whose health is compromised, as well as any spectators who are exhibiting Covid-19 related symptoms, stay home.
